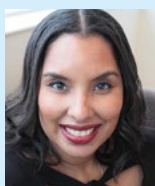


Your Updates Can Change Lives

Why do my updates matter?

Current clinical trial information can mean the difference between patients having access to potential treatment options, or not. This is particularly important for patients in circumstances where treatment choices are limited or there are none.

Clinicians and patients rely on you communicating updates to be able to search for current trials. Please see some user stories below which highlight the importance of why keeping content up to date is important:

What do trial updates include?

- New trials opening for recruitment or pending.
- Trial status changes- this includes reporting trial closures or studies that have been put on hold.
- Site contact or location information changes. It is important that people can reach nominated contacts to make enquiries

What are the benefits of keeping trial updates current?

- Current trial information ensures clinicians and patients are able to access potentially life changing treatment options that are relevant now. It can be disappointing for them if they find trials that have a status of being open to recruitment but are actually closed.
- If your trial information is up to date clinicians and patients feel confident they can rely on the content being accessed. This will support repeat access and referrals.
- Improved visibility of your site to patients, clinicians and sponsors as a reputable site they can rely on.
- Improved referral and recruitment rates to your trials.



How do I report Updates?

You are able to report your trial status updates directly to your designated App Manager(s). In some circumstances Location Manager permission can be assigned so that you can directly make updates to your trial data independently, in real time.
